

Rural Municipality of Loon Lake #561

BYLAW No. 1/11

A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Loon Lake #561, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
 - c) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Loon Lake No.561
2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the persons who receive the service on accordance with Schedule "A" which is attached to and forming a part of this bylaw.
3. The Council may authorize the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of calendar year.

Schedule A

Set Rates for Billing Fire Costs

That the Village and the Municipality shall provide firefighting services to the incorporated areas of the Municipality and the Village on a fee – for – services basis.

On a fee for services basis the Village of Makwa shall be considered to be within the incorporated area of the Municipality.

The fees charged for firefighting services in the incorporated area shall be as follows:

1. \$200.00 per hour for Water Truck
2. \$400.00 per hour for Fire Truck (Pumper)
3. \$30.00 per hour for the Fire Chief
4. \$25.00 per hour for the Fire Fighters
5. \$350.00 for False Alarms
6. \$350.00 for Minimum Charge

The fees charged for firefighting services outside the incorporated area shall be as follows:

1. \$300.00 per hour for Water Truck
2. \$500.00 per hour for Fire Truck (Pumper)
3. \$35.00 per hour for the Fire Chief
4. \$30.00 per hour for the Fire Fighters
5. 450.00 for Minimum Charge
