

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE  
CONTROL AND DESTRUCTION OF GRASSHOPPERS  
ON LAND WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY

WHEREAS by Section 3 of the Pest Control Act, the Minister of Agriculture may by order published in The Saskatchewan Gazette declare any animal, insect or disease that he deems likely to be destructive of or dangerous to any crops, grain, livestock or other property to be a pest for the purpose of the said Act; and

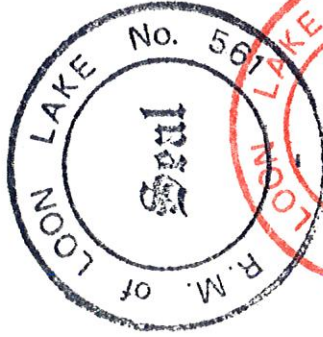
WHEREAS the said Minister has by order published in the issue of the Saskatchewan Gazette for June 17, 1957, declared grasshoppers to be a pest for the purpose of the said Act; and

WHEREAS power is vested in the Council of the Municipality by Section 12 of the Pest Control Act, to enact bylaws for the control of any pest to which such Act relates;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Loon Lake No. 561, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- (1) For the purpose of this by-law the expression:  
"crop year" means the period from April 15<sup>th</sup> to October 15<sup>th</sup> of the same year, each year that the bylaw is in effect or until it is rescinded.  
"owner" includes every person who owns, occupies or controls land within the municipality during the crop year.
- (2) Every owner shall take the following measures for the control and destruction of grasshoppers:
  - He shall be responsible for the application of chemicals on his land, that is, in his opinion and/or in the opinion of the Committee, warrants such application; and
  - He shall be responsible for the application of chemicals within the area lying between the centre line of the road allowance adjoining his land and the nearest boundary of the said land, that is, in his opinion and/or in the opinion of the Committee, warrants such application.
- (3) The Council shall designate chemical distribution outlets as such chemicals are needed.
- (4) The Municipality shall not be responsible for the cost of purchasing such chemicals from the Chemical Distribution Outlet, in accordance with this bylaw; and shall not be responsible for raising the amount of the cost of such chemicals by charging a general tax upon all lands of the Municipality.
- (5) The Council of the Municipality shall in each year appoint a committee to be known as the "Grasshopper Control Committee", including the Pest Control Officer, to administer this bylaw.
- (6) This bylaw is in effect until rescinded.

READ THREE TIMES by unanimous vote, and passed by the Council of the Rural Municipality of Loon Lake No. 561 at Loon Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan this 14<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1983.
